

CAFE LUDWIG

Located inside the Museum Ludwig, this airy cafe has a wide selection of sweet & savory options

CAFE REICHARD

Amazing location in front of the cathedral. Cakes & sweets are especially nice.

CAFE EIGEL

Locally loved spot with a tempting assortment of German cakes. Nice seasonal window displays.

Cake and coffee is a customary afternoon practice for Germans,. Black Forest Cake is NOT common in this region. Instead, a typical order would be an Apple Cake or Cheesecake.

FRÜH

One of the most famous names in Kölsch beer in a massive space

GAFFEL

Very close to the cathedral

MALZMÜHLE

One of only two breweries still brewing in its original location

PETERS

Best pub food with great Kölsch

PÄFFGEN

Longest running brewery in the original location. They don't bottle the beer, so you can only try it in person

Oldest brewery in Cologne with the friendliest waiters (Köbes)


